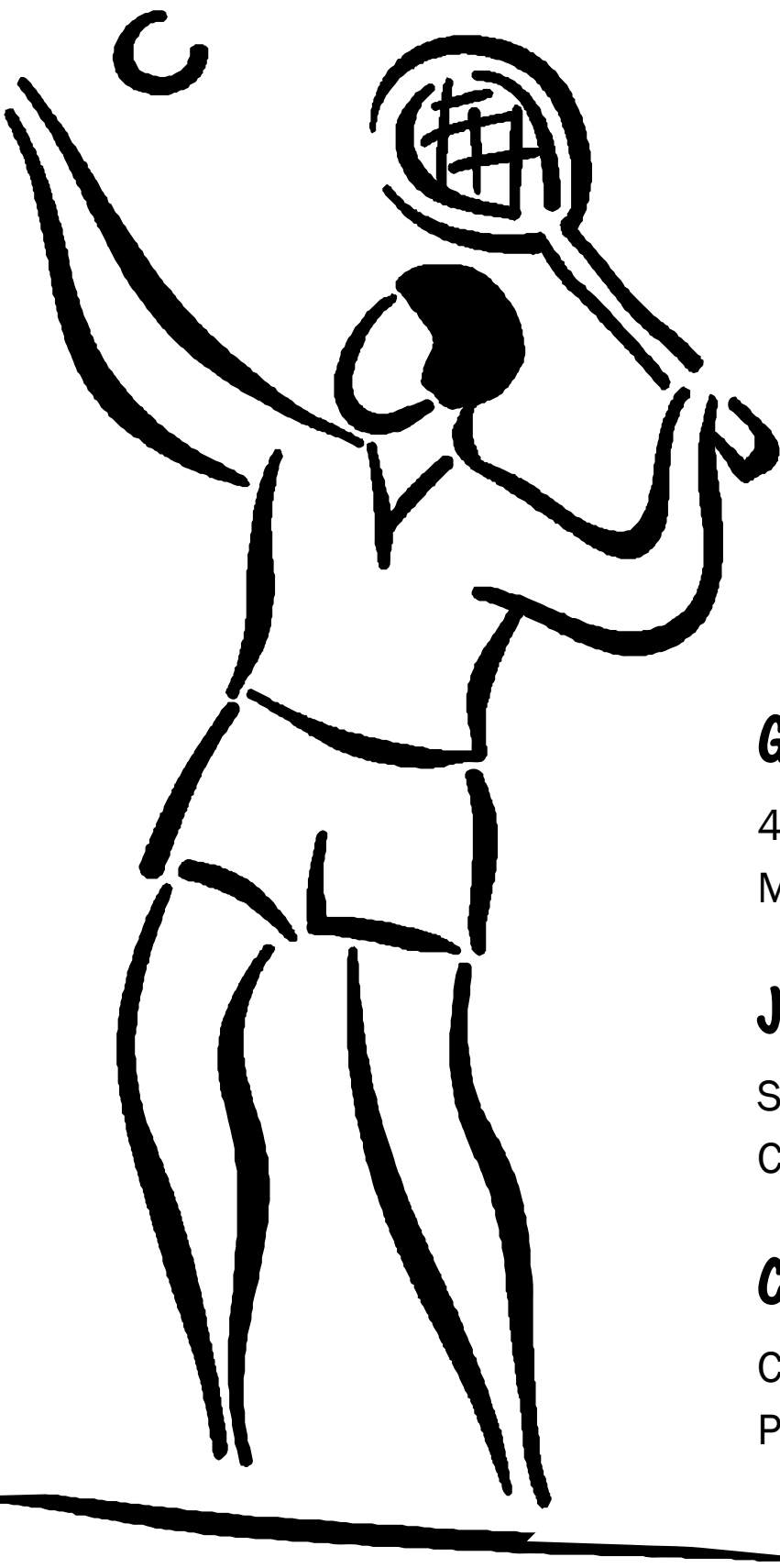

Keys for Court Access & Floodlights

Once the annual subscription has been paid, each senior member (or each household as applicable) will receive a key for access to the courts. A deposit of £10.00 must be paid which is refundable when membership is terminated. Members are responsible for the safekeeping of their key and for locking the complex after use. Replacement keys will be charged at £20.00.

Members wishing to use the floodlights can purchase an access key for £2.00.

Non Member's Play & Daytime Court Bookings

Non-members can play for £6.00 per person per session (1hour), £3.00 for under 18's. This is payable to court attendants when on duty or any other member of the club present at the time. Schools and companies wishing to book our courts should contact membership@portadowntennisclub.com.
